Teacher Instructions

- We've created this Graphic Organizer for the Social Studies Classroom that incorporates Paper Live Chat feature (to be printed front/back)
- This activity pairs with a standard that focuses on: Countries, Culture, or Major Components of History
- Designed to help students learn more about the topic, get clarification and feedback, and proofread their sentences from a Paper Tutor
- Use in class or as a homework assignment
- Provide students with the location of where you want the information to come from (specific websites, encyclopedias, printable articles, etc...)

Ideas for Use in the Classroom or for Homework

- 1. Students can display their final country projects in a number of different ways (trifold, slide presentation, poster, brochure, information booklet, etc...)
- 2. Another option: Teachers can pick ONE specific continent, and assign each student or group of students a different country in that specific continent.
- 3. If used in the classroom, this can be completed individually, as pairs, or in a group. If implemented in a group setting, one student should be responsible for chatting with the live tutor to relay information to other group members.
